Not a bit, because Savory Choice broth, made in South San Francisco, comes in portable, storable, finger-sized foil pouches of broth concentrate. Each pouch makes a full cup of broth or stock. I love the fact that the broth pouches mean I don't have to fill my recycle bin with empty broth cans. And I also love the real, homemade flavor of the broth, which is literally fresher than broth out of a can. The chicken, turkey and beef broth have been around a while, but the slightly sweet, rich vegetable broth is brand new. The broth is \$6 for 12 pouches.
